3rd SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST — **Tone 2. All Saints of Britain and Ireland.** Martyr Julian of Tarsus in Cilicia (3rd-4th c.). Hieromartyr Terence (Tertius), Bishop of Iconium (1st c.). St. Julius, Presbyter of Novara, and his brother, St. Julian the Deacon (5th c.). Martyrs Archil II (744) and Luarsab II (1622), Kings of Georgia.

**Tone 2 Troparion (Resurrection)**

Let us all worthily praise Julian today, the unconquerable pious warrior and seeker of truth; To him let us cry out: "Pray to Christ God for us all!"
