## Today's commemorated feasts and saint

**8th SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST — Tone 7. Translation of the Relics of Ven. Theodosius of the Kiev Caves (1091).**  
Forefeast of the Dormition. Prophet Micah (8th c. B.C.). Ven. Arcadius of Novotorzhk (11th c.). Hieromartyr Marcellus, Bishop of Apamea (ca. 389).

### Tone 7 Troparion (Resurrection)

By Your Cross You destroyed death. To the thief You opened Paradise. For the Myrrhbearers You changed weeping into joy. And You commanded Your disciples, O Christ God, to proclaim that You are risen,// granting the world great mercy.

### Tone 1 Troparion (Dormition)

In giving birth you preserved your virginity. In falling asleep you did not forsake the world, O Theotokos. You were translated to life O Mother of Life,// and by your prayers you deliver our souls from death.

### Tone 7 Kottakion (Resurrection)

The dominion of death can no longer hold mankind cap-  
tive, for Christ descended, shattering and destroying its powers. Hell is bound, while the Prophets rejoice and cry: "The Savior has come to those in faith;// enter, you faithful, into the Resurrec-  
tion!"

### Tone 2 Kontakion (Dormition)

Neither the tomb, nor death, could hold the Theotokos, who is constant in prayer and our firm hope in her inter-  
cessions. For being the Mother of Life,// she was translated to life by the One Who dwelt in her virginal womb.

### Tone 3 Prokeimenon (Song of the Theotokos)

My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior.

(Lk 1:46-47) *v: For He has regarded the low estate of His handmaiden, for behold, all generations will call me blessed. (Lk 1:48)*

### Tone 1

**Refrain:** The Angels, as they looked upon the Dormition of the Virgin, were struck with wonder, seeing how the Virgin went up from earth to heaven.

**Heirmos:** The limits of nature are overcome in you, O Pure Virgin: for birthgiving remains virginal, and life is united to death; a virgin after childbearing and alive after death, you ever save your inheritance, O Theotokos.

### Communion Hymn

I will receive the cup of salvation and call on the name of the Lord. (Ps 115/116:13) Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!
