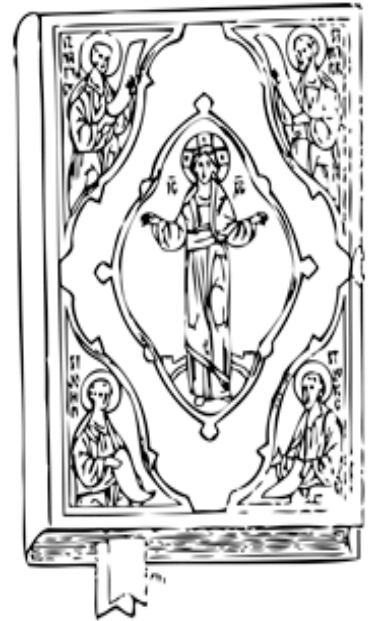

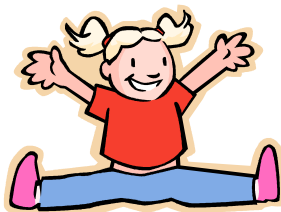
If you would like to organize March’s HAYOUTH activity, see Joan.
