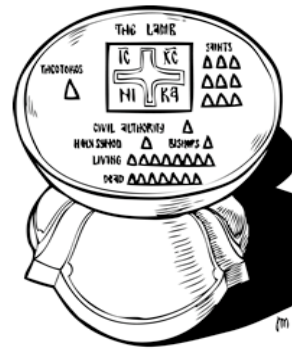


Luke 18:35-43 (Gospel)

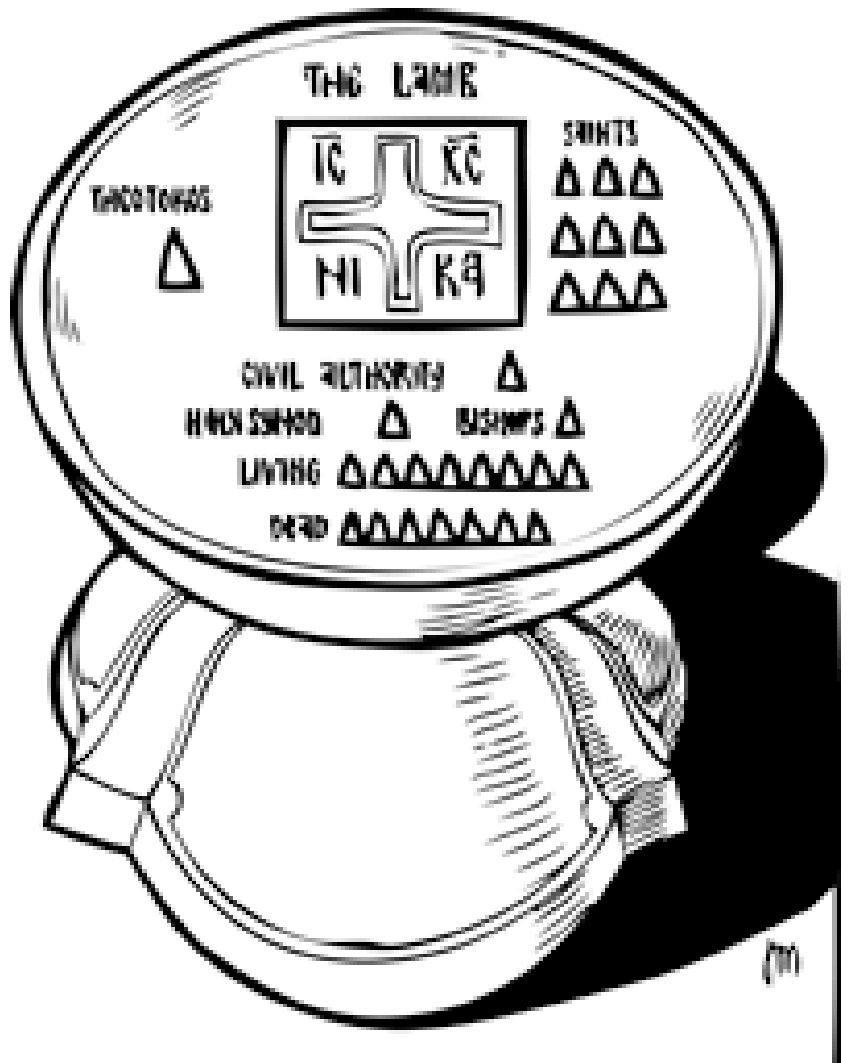
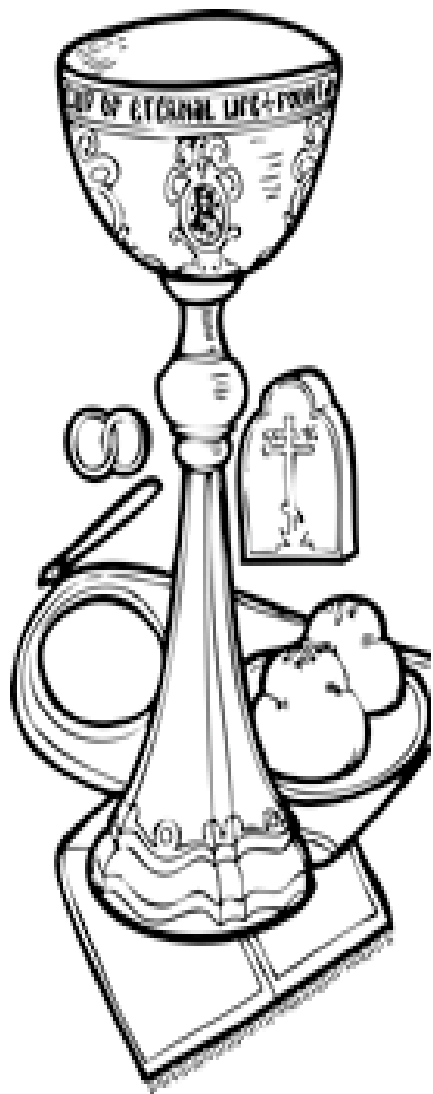
