5th SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST — Tone 4. Fathers of the 1st Six Ecumenical Councils. Synaxis of the Archangel Gabriel. Ven. Stephen of St. Sabbas' Monastery (794). St. Julian, Bishop of Cenomanis (Le Mans) in Gaul (1st c.). Martyr Serapion (2nd-3rd c.). Martyr Marcian of Iconium (258). Icon of the Most-holy Theotokos "AXION ESTIN" ("IT IS TRULY MEET").

Tone 4 Troparion (Resurrection)
 When the women Disciples of the Lord learned from the Angel the joyous message of the Resurrection, they cast away the ancestral curse and elatedly told the Apostles: "Death is overthrown! Christ God is risen, // granting the world great mercy!"

Tone 8 Troparion (Holy Fathers)
 You are most glorious, O Christ our God!
 You have established the Holy Fathers as lights on the earth. Through them You have guided us to the true Faith. // O greatly compassionate One, glory to You!

Tone 4 Kontakion (Resurrection)
 My Savior and Redeemer as God rose from the tomb and delivered the earth-born from their chains. He has shattered the gates of hell, and as Master, // He has risen on the third day!

Tone 8 Kontakion (Holy Fathers)
 The Apostles' preaching and the Fathers' doctrines have established one Faith for the Church. Adorned with the robe of truth, woven from heavenly theology, // it defines and glorifies the great mystery of piety.

This Special Assembly will be followed on the same day by a regular Diocesan Assembly, during which the business of an annual Diocesan Assembly meeting will be addressed.
