### Tone 3 Troparion (Resurrection)

Let the heavens rejoice! Let the earth be glad!  
For the Lord has shown strength with His arm.  
He has trampled down death by death.  
He has become the first born of the dead.  
He has delivered us from the depths of hell,  
and has granted to the world// great mercy.

### Tone 1 Troparion (Venerable Sisoës)

Dweller of the desert and Angel in the body,  
You were shown to be a wonder-worker, our
