19th SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST — **Tone 2.** Prophet Joel (ca. 800 B.C.). Martyr Varus, and with him six Monk Martyrs (ca. 307). Translation of the Relics of Ven. John, Abbot of Rila in Bulgaria (1238). Bl. Cleopatra and her son John, in Egypt (327). Hieromartyr Sadoc (Sadoth), Bishop of Persia, and 128 Martyrs with him (342).

Tone 2 Troparion (Resurrection)
 When You descended to death, O Life Immortal, You destroyed hell with the splendor of Your Godhead. And when from the depths You raised the dead, all the powers of heaven cried out:// "O Giver of life, Christ our God, glory to You!"

Tone 2 Troparion (Prophet Joel)
 We celebrate the memory of Your Prophet Joel, O Lord; through him we beseech You:// "Save our souls!"

Tone 4 Troparion (Martyr Varus)
 Your holy martyr Varus, O Lord, through his suffering has received an incorruptible crown from You, our God. For having Your strength, he laid low his adversaries and shattered the powerless boldness of demons.// Through his intercessions, save our souls!

Tone 2 Kontakion (Resurrection)
 Hell became afraid, O almighty Savior, seeing the miracle of Your Resurrection from the tomb! The dead arose! Creation, with Adam, beheld this and rejoiced with You, // and the world, my Savior, praises You forever.

Tone 4 Kontakion (Martyr Varus)
 Following Christ, O Martyr Varus, you drank of His chalice; you received the crown of martyrdom and now rejoice with the Angels.// Pray for our souls unceasingly!

The Lord is my strength and my song; He has become my salvation.

• **Outdoor Family Film Night** has been moved to November 2nd.

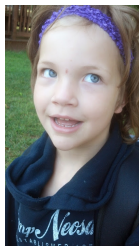
