 When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Your most pure body, You rose on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. The powers of heaven therefore cried to You, O Giver of Life: "Glory to Your Resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Your Kingdom! // Glory to Your dispensation, O Lover of mankind!"

Tone 8 Troparion (Fathers)
 You are most glorious, O Christ our God! You have established the Holy Fathers as lights on the earth. Through them You have guided us to the true Faith. // O greatly compassionate One, glory to You!

Tone 1 Kontakion (Resurrection)
 As God, You rose from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Yourself. Human nature praises You as God, for death has vanished. Adam exults, O Master!

Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and cries to You: // "You are the Giver of Resurrection to all, O Christ!"

Tone 6 Kontakion (Fathers)
 The Son who shone forth from the Father was ineffably born, two-fold in nature, of a woman. Having beheld Him, we do not deny the image of His form, but depict it piously and revere it faithfully. Thus, keeping the True Faith, // the Church venerates the icon of Christ Incarnate.

Tone 1 Prokeimenon
 Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us as we have set our hope on You! (Ps 32/33:22) *v: Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! Praise befits the just!* (Ps 32/33:1)

 Blessed are You, O Lord God of our Fathers and praised and glorified is Your Name forever! (Daniel 3:26: Song of the Three Holy Children *v.3*)

Luke 7:11-16 John 17:1-13 **(Fathers)**



Hebrews 13:7-18a
⁷ Remember your leaders who spoke the word of God to you; consider the outcome of their life, and imitate their faith. ⁸ Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. ⁹ Do not be led away by diverse and strange teachings; for it is well that the heart be strengthened by grace, not by foods, which have not benefited their adherents. ¹⁰ We have an altar from which those who serve the tent^u have no right to eat. ¹¹ For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest as a sacrifice for sin are burned outside the camp. ¹² So Jesus also suffered outside the gate in order to sanctify the people through his own blood. ¹³ Therefore let us go forth to him outside the camp, and bear the abuse he endured. ¹⁴ For here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city which is to

come. ¹⁵ Through him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name. ¹⁶ Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.

¹⁷ Obey your leaders and submit to them; for they are keeping watch over your souls, as men who will have to give account. Let them do this joyfully, and not sadly, for that would be of no advantage to you. ¹⁸ Pray for us

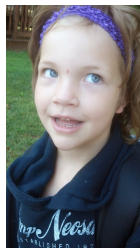
