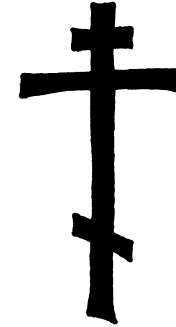

## TROPARIA AND KONTAKIA

### **Tone 1**      **Troparion**      *(Resurrection)*

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews,  
while the soldiers were guarding Your most pure body,  
You rose on the third day, O Savior,  
granting life to the world.  
The powers of heaven therefore cried to You, O Giver of Life:  
“Glory to Your Resurrection, O Christ!  
Glory to Your Kingdom!  
Glory to Your dispensation, O Lover of mankind!”

### **Tone 4**      **Troparion**      *(St. Nestor)*

Your holy martyr Nestor, O Lord,  
through his sufferings has received an incorruptible crown from You, our  
God.  
For having Your strength, he laid low his adversaries,  
and shattered the powerless boldness of demons.  
Through his intercession, save our souls!

### **Tone 1**      **Kontakion**      *(Resurrection)*

As God, You rose from the tomb in glory,  
raising the world with Yourself.  
Human nature praises You as God, for death has vanished.  
Adam exults, O Master!  
Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and cries to You:  
“You are the Giver of Resurrection to all, O Christ!”

### **Tone 2**      **Kontakion**      *(St. Nestor)*

Having fought the good fight,  
you won immortal glory, O Nestor.  
You became a perfect soldier for the Master  
through the prayers of the martyr Demetrius.  
Together with him you are praying unceasingly to Christ God for us all.
