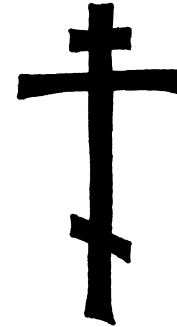

Tone 2 **Kontakion** *(Apostles)*
