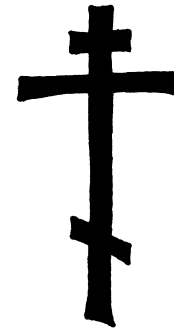

### **Tone 4**      **Troparion**      *(Resurrection)*

### **Tone 8**      **Troparion**      *(St. Gregory)*

that we may not sleep in sin, which leads to death!

### **Tone 4**      **Kontakion**      *(Resurrection)*

He has risen on the third day!

### **Tone 2**      **Kontakion**      *(St. Gregory)*
