**Tone 7 Troparion** (Resurrection)

By Your Cross You destroyed death.  
To the thief You opened Paradise.  
For the Myrrhbearers You changed weeping into joy.  
And You commanded Your disciples,  
O Christ God,  
to proclaim that You are risen,  
granting the world great mercy.

**Tone 1 Troparion** (St Gregory the Theologian)

The sweet-sounding shepherd's pipe of your theology overpowered the trumpeting of the orators; for eloquence was also bestowed on you, as on one who searched the depths of the Spirit.  
Pray to Christ God, Father Gregory, that our souls may be saved!

## Kontakions

**Tone 7 Kontakion** (Resurrection)

The dominion of death can no longer hold mankind captive,  
for Christ descended, shattering and destroying its powers.  
Hell is bound, while the Prophets rejoice and cry:  
"The Savior has come to those in faith;  
enter, you faithful, into the Resurrection!"

**Tone 3 Kontakion** (St Gregory the Theologian)

By words of theology you unraveled the complex webs of the orators,  
glorious Gregory,  
and adorned the Church with the robe of Orthodoxy, woven from on high.  
Wearing it, she cries out with us, her children:  
"Rejoice, O Father, supreme mind of theology!"

**Tone 7 Prokeimenon** (Resurrection)

The Lord shall give strength to His people; the Lord shall bless His people with peace. (Ps 28/29:11)

*v: Offer to the Lord, O your sons of God! Offer young rams to the Lord!. (Ps 28/29:1)*

**Tone 1 Prokeimenon**

My mouth shall speak wisdom, the meditation of my heart shall be understanding. (Ps 48/49:3)

## EPISTLE

### 1 Timothy 1:15-17 (Epistle)

15 This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief. 16 However, for this reason I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show all longsuffering, as a pattern to those who are going to believe on Him for everlasting life. 17 Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

**1 Corinthians 12:7-11 (Epistle, Saint)**

7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: 8 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

**Matthew 15:21-28 (Gospel, Canaanite Woman)**

21 Then Jesus went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon. 22 And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed." 23 But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us." 24 But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." 25 Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!" 26 But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs." 27 And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table." 28 Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour.

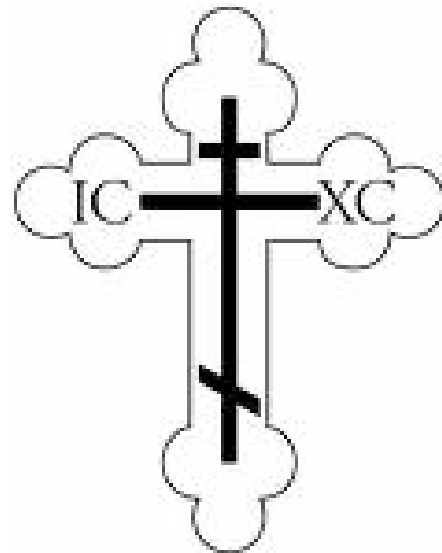
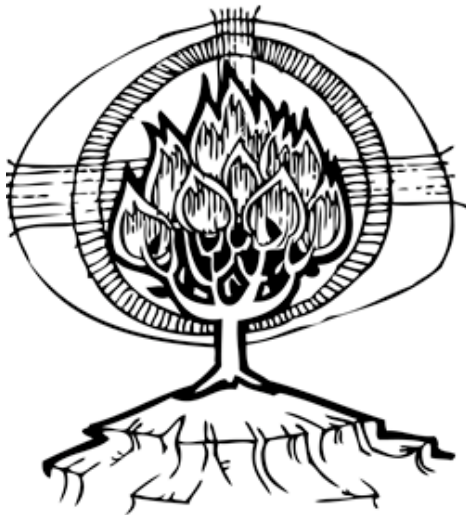


**John 10:9-16 (Gospel, Saint)**

9 I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. 10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly. 11 I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep. 12 But a hireling, he who is not the shepherd, one who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees; and the wolf catches the sheep and scatters them. 13 The hireling flees because he is a hireling and does not care about the sheep. 14 I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own. 15 As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. 16 And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock and one shepherd.
